In our county, the Latinx population was the most disproportionately impacted with about half of COVID cases occurring among this population even though people who identify as Latinx make up only 15 to 17% of the total population. Our communications efforts focused on creating materials to reach the Latinx and Spanish-speaking population along with our English speaking population. We also focused on populations that were more likely to get COVID because they lived in multi-generational housing, congregate living centers or because they were essential workers who didn't have the privilege of working from home during the pandemic.
