

RE: BASALT CREEK PARKWAY EXTENSION PROJECT UPDATE

This letter is to inform you on the current status of the Basalt Creek Parkway Extension Project.

Since the open house held in October 2019, the project has been refined. The project team requested a recommendation from the County Board of Commissioners on the bicycle and pedestrian facilities for the project. The recommendation made includes a 12-foot multiuse path on both sides of the parkway. The new proposed cross section is below.

The project is proceeding with the preferred alignment displayed at the October 2019 open house, with the multiuse path. The project will now advance to a 30% design level, known as a



Design Acceptance Package. Elements such as drainage needs, retaining wall locations, bridge type, environmental impacts and mitigation measures, and any additional environmental permitting requirements are included in the package.

The County will host an open in the fall of 2020 to gather feedback on the latest design. Notification for the open house will be sent out closer to the date.
