

Project Location and Planned Improvements

Thompson Road (Saltzman Road to Marcotte Road)

- We will widen Thompson Road, between Saltzman and Marcotte roads, adding:
 - Center turn lane
 - Bike lanes
 - Sidewalks
- Other improvements include:
 - Street lighting
 - Storm drainage
 - Water quality facilities
 - Traffic signs and road striping





Thompson (Saltzman to Marcotte)

Next steps

- Survey and design start: December 2022
- Open house events: July 2023 and November 2023*
- Design finish: May 2024*
- Right-of-way acquisition: November 2023 – July 2024*
- Construction start: Fall 2024*
- Construction finish: Fall 2025*

*Timeframes are estimated




Project Location and Planned Improvements

Filbert Street (Murray Road to Saltzman Road)

We will build a 5-foot-wide sidewalk along the south side of Filbert Street from Murray Road to Saltzman Road

Other improvements include:

- ADA-compliant curb ramps
- Concrete median at the east end of Filbert for traffic calming and pedestrian safety crossing Filbert north to south





Filbert Street (Murray to Saltzman)

Next steps

- Open house: October 2020
- Design completed: December 2022
- Right-of-way acquisition completed: January 2023
- Construction contractor bid/selection: February/March 2023
- Construction start: Spring 2023
- Construction finish: Fall 2023*


Next steps
