Homeless to Work Program

New Applicant Referral Process

1. All applicants will be referred from a County, State, or nonprofit organization based on their ability to work, and that they meet HUD's guidelines for being "homeless".
2. As this is a homeless to work program, applicants must be able and willing to find employment.
3. *Bridges To Change* does not discriminate based on race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or any other factor, and adheres to all fair housing laws.
4. All applicants that have a mental health diagnosis that would prevent them from working full time, but would be able to work if stable on medications, must be on medications and stable before entering house.
5. Applicants will be put on a wait list and admitted to the program based on the date they were put on the wait list, first come, first served basis.
6. As the house is A & D free all applicants must be willing to comply with OAR's on this type of housing.
7. Applicants will be notified in person or through referring agency in a timely manner regarding acceptance or non-acceptance into the program.
8. Program will serve unaccompanied adults age 18 and older.
