**Welcome**

Gary Virgin called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. Dave Vanasche motioned to approve the May minutes and Bill Ewers seconded the motion.

**ODOT STIP 08-11**

ODOT was unable to attend the meeting.

**Scotch Church Road**

Tom Tushner discussed citizen concerns regarding the traffic on Scotch Church Road. Tom videotaped the road on a Sunday during church service to get a better idea of what the issues were.

It appears that the issue is parking. Cars are currently parking perpendicular to the roadway rather than parallel. This creates a sight distance issue for pedestrians as well as motorists. Ken Moyle asked why the church doesn't have a parking lot. Jean Mosley from the church stated that with the cemetery on both sides of the church, there was not enough property for a parking lot either across the street or near the actual church. Tom mentioned that eliminating the perpendicular parking would help. Jim Burns felt like a no parking sign in the front would be best. The church really doesn't want that because that would keep people from coming.

The church will pursue other options at this time.

## **Work Program Status**

The work program for FY 2006-2007 is scheduled to be approved by The Board on June 27. This work program includes nine roads that the County will not provide maintenance on this coming year. There will be clear direction from the Board to limit liability to the County for these roads.

## **Gravel Road Upgrades**

The committee suggested that all gravel roads be on the upgrade list even if they are very low profile. Completed roads should all be listed on the top. The gravel road upgrade rating plan will soon be available on the County website.

## **Miscellaneous:**

The issue of subgrade drainage was discussed. A consultant will be asked to review issues and current data with recommendations to be reported back to the committee. Several members feel that subgrade drainage is an issue for road surfacing life. Dave Vanasche discussed drainage as a cause of the surface failure on Dick Road.

ODOT's design for Hwy 219 at Farmington has raised concern from RROMAC. RROMAC will form a subcommittee consisting of Gary Virgin, Bill Ewers, and Ken Moyle to address this issue. RROMAC would like to have ODOT revisit their design and include the intersection of Bald Peak as well.

Jackson School interchange discussion on separation of water quality facility with fence. Dave Schamp offered to invite Rick Raetz to RROMAC to explain.

Susbauer Road bridge replacement will begin soon.

Eldon Jossi motioned to adjourn and Keith Fishback seconded the motion.
