### **Pedestrian Walking in Road Killed in Crash**

September 22, 2017 – Sheriff's Deputies responded to a crash where a 37-year-old man was hit by a truck while walking in the roadway. The pedestrian did not survive his injuries.

On Friday, September 22, 2017, at 9:03 p.m., Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to check on a male walking in traffic near SW Tualatin Valley Highway/NW 334<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Hillsboro. A deputy arrived on scene quickly and found that the pedestrian, 37-year-old Patrick D. Beneman, had been hit by a full-size pickup truck.

Deputies rendered aid until medical personnel arrived, but Mr. Beneman was pronounced deceased at the scene. The driver of the truck stayed on scene and cooperated with the investigation.

The Washington County Crash Analysis Reconstruction Team (CART), Hillsboro Fire Department, Metro West, and the Washington County Medical Examiner's Office assisted with the investigation.

Mr. Beneman's family has been notified.
