### Man Robs Cedar Mill Branch of Umpqua Bank – Public's Help Needed

June 9, 2017 – On June 9, 2017, just before 5:00 p.m., a man walked into the Umpqua Bank branch located in the 7300 block of SW Barnes Road in the community of Cedar Mill. He approached the teller, implied a weapon and demanded money.

The man received an undisclosed amount of cash and then fled the bank on foot. Beaverton Police Officer Gaunt and his K9 partner "Ike" assisted deputies by tracking the suspect. The suspect was not immediately located.
