

Training Requirements

Providers

- ❑ Completion of the Adult Foster Care Basic Training Program
- ❑ Current First Aid and CPR from approved agency (American Heart Association, the American Red Cross, the American Safety and Health Institute, or MEDIC First Aid)
- ❑ Mandatory Abuse Reporter Training annually
- ❑ 12 hours of annual AFH Training Credit Committee approved training hours

 - ★ *Foster providers may also request approval for trainings that are not posted on the state website.*
- ❑ Current Oregon Intervention System (OIS) may be required, based on the individuals served
- ❑ Training by RN for delegated tasks may be required, based on the individuals served
- ❑ Resident Record Keeping classes recommended

Substitute Caregivers

- ❑ Completion of the Adult Foster Care Basic Training Program
- ❑ Orientation to home and care giving duties
- ❑ Mandatory Abuse Reporter Training annually
- ❑ Current Oregon Intervention System (OIS) may be required, based on the individuals served
- ❑ Annual training on individuals' ISPs and emergency procedures
- ❑ Annual training on home's emergency plan
- ❑ 12 hours of annual AFH Training Credit Committee approved training hours (see information above regarding training approval)
- ❑ First Aid/CPR recommended
- ❑ Training by RN for delegated tasks may be required, based on the individuals served
- ❑ Resident Record Keeping classes recommended
