Chapter 8.08 - SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SITES

8.08.130 - <u>Garbage and Recycling</u> Advisory <u>Committee</u> <u>Duties</u>.

There is created a garbage and recycling advisory committee as outlined in Washington County Code Chapter 8.04.060.

8.08.135 Garbage and Recycling Advisory Committee – Duties

- A. Make periodic reports containing <u>committeeits</u> recommendations, if any, regarding proposed changes or additions to the regulations promulgated by the board or amendments to this chapter as set forth in Section 8.08.020;
- B. Review and make recommendations related to, in consultation with county officers and departments, including but not limited to, the health and human services department, the county administrative office, the land use and transportation department, and such state, local or federal offices, agencies and departments as the board and the committee deem necessary, appropriate long-range plans related to the provision of adequate disposal sites and disposal facilities to meet future demands, including but not limited to the regional solid waste management plan, which plans shall subsequently be recommended to the board for approval;
- C. Review and recommend, in consultation with necessary state, federal and local officials of this and other counties, cities or public agencies and private persons, minimum standards for the location and operation of disposal sites including, but not limited to, protection of adjacent or nearby residents;
- D. Perform such other acts or duties as directed by the board or established by other ordinances or as may be necessary, proper or desirable to carry out effectively, the functions and duties of the committee and the intent of this chapter. (Ord. 83 § 8, 1971) (Ord. No. 728, § 3, 10-20-2009)
