Project information

- Install traffic signal at the intersection of Cornelius Pass and Old Cornelius Pass roads
- Limit a portion of Germantown Road (Old Cornelius Pass Road) traffic to eastbound only between Cornelius Pass and Old Cornelius Pass roads
- Improve traffic flow at all intersections
- Install Elk signs

Traffic impacts

- Lane closures
 - o 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Cornelius Pass and Germantown roads
 - o 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. Old Cornelius Pass Road
- Traffic may be stopped up to 10 minutes at a time or routed to a different road
- Utility potholing Feb. 10-14
- Construction Feb. 17-May 31

Transfer to the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

- HB 2017 included the transfer of Cornelius Pass Road, between U.S. 26 and U.S. 30, to ODOT
- Transfer date will be scheduled after current Washington and Multnomah county road improvement projects are completed:
 - Washington County
 - Cornelius Pass/Germantown/Old Cornelius Pass roads intersection
 - Cornelius Pass Road bridge over Rock Creek
 - Multnomah County
 - Cornelius Pass Road Safety Improvements (Old Cornelius Pass Road to U.S. 30)
