Services Provided by Washington County Public Health (M110):

Communicable Disease at Needle Exchange

- Twice per week
- HIV Testing, prevention, and referrals at needle exchange
- Wound bandages and Wound kit distribution
- **Upcoming:** Hep C testing, Rapid HIV/Syphilis combo pilot

Communicable Disease at High-Risk Clinic

- One day per week
- Full STI screening (HIV, syphilis, chlamydia, gonorrhea)
- Treatment for positive STI clients and exposed partners
- MPox vaccinations
- Access to immediate addiction referral services

Community-Based Outreach & Technical Assistance

- Collaborate with community partners on expanding harm reduction programs and supply distribution
- Provide trainings to community partners on harm reduction and overdose prevention
- Harm Reduction Committee

Epidemiology and Data Support

- Support data collection and analysis
- Evaluate data trends
- Support program development
- Support BHRN partners

Services Provided by HIV Alliance in Washington County

Needle exchange (includes):

- Twice per week, two harm reduction coordinators
- Safe injection supplies and syringe disposal
- Overdose prevention education & naloxone distribution
- Referrals to services including substance use treatment, mental health treatment, housing, healthcare services, etc.

Peer Recovery Specialists

- Ongoing case management
- Warm hand off to treatment
- Assistance with basic needs






