Background/Context

- Washington County will be working over the next biennium to develop its local Modernization Implementation Plan (MIP)
- The MIP will outline how Washington County, as the local public health authority, will implement all the foundational capabilities and programs outlined by the state legislature
- This plan will be developed using feedback collected from internal and external stakeholders

Think, Pair, Share

- You'll be assigned a foundational capability
 - Orange = Health equity and cultural responsiveness
 - Pink = community partnership development
 - Blue = Communications
- Look at the core system functions for your capability and tell us what it would look like to you for that to be fully implemented
- You'll do an initial brainstorm on your own, before pairing up with others

Think

- Pick 1-3 core system functions from your capability and identify what you think it would look like to implement
 - What are the systems that should be in place
 - What are the needs of the community related to the function
