DUII Driver Attempts to Elude Deputies

December 15, 2013 – On Sunday afternoon, an Aloha woman crashed into several vehicles while driving intoxicated. When deputies located her, she attempted to flee by speeding up and pulling away from deputies. She was stopped and taken into custody.

At 3:57 p.m., Washington County Deputies received a report of a hit and run on SW Alexander Street in Aloha. This is located in the Enhanced Sheriff's Patrol District (ESPD). En route to the hit and run call, a deputy located a vehicle matching the suspect vehicle driving on SW Johnson Street with one tire missing. When the deputy attempted to stop the vehicle, the driver accelerated.



After a brief pursuit, deputies were able to stop the driver, Shawn Davenport, 53, of Aloha. In an attempt to elude deputies, Ms. Davenport drove her 2005 Jeep down a dead end street and stopped in front of her residence. During the course of the investigation, deputies determined Ms. Davenport was driving intoxicated.

Ms. Davenport was arrested for DUII, Failure to Perform Duties of a Driver and Felony Elude. She was lodged in the Washington County

Jail with a \$5000.00 bail.

The Washington County Sheriff's Office advises citizens not to drive after the consumption of alcohol or drugs. If you must travel, the Sheriff's Office encourages citizens to pre-arrange a designated driver.
