## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This island annexation, initiated by the Banks City Council, involves the back (western-most) 30 feet of 21 separate lots. The majority of all 21 lots lie within the city limits. But when these lots annexed into the city in 2016, the western-most 30 was left out. The western-most 30 feet of these lots currently exists as an island of unincorporated Washington County land completely surrounded by incorporated City of Banks. Thus, the annexation proposal will bring the rest of these 21 lots into the city limits at no cost to the property owners. This annexation will not increase development potential of the lots, nor will it increase the city's population. Upon annexation, these lots will be zoned $R-5$ single-family residential, the same as the portion of these lots already within the city. Upon annexation these lots will be assessed and taxed the same as other similarly situated residential property in the city. This annexation will eliminate islands of unincorporated Washington County land and result in a more logical and appropriate city boundary.
