WHEREAS, community corrections and juvenile justice professionals advocate community and
restorative justice; and

WHEREAS, community corrections and juvenile justice professionals are a true Force for Positive
Change in their communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that on this 17th day of July, 2018, the Washington
County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim July 15-21, 2018 as Community Corrections
and Juvenile Justice Community Supervision Week and encourages all citizens to honor these
community corrections and juvenile justice professionals and to recognize their achievements.
