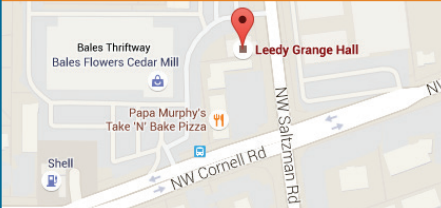

Metro Low or No-Emission Bus Program Amendment Submit Your Comments by December 30

TriMet has been awarded a federal grant to purchase zero-emission battery electric buses with en-route fast-charging equipment and depot plug-in charging as part of its plans to procure future zero emission buses to create a cleaner, more energy-efficient fleet. An amendment to the *2015-18 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program* is required as a result. The buses will operate primarily in Washington County out of the Merlo garage.
