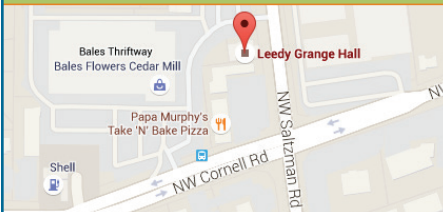

*How do Washington County commuters get to Portland? What are the barriers, and where are the opportunities to improve commuting for those who live in Washington County but work in Portland?*

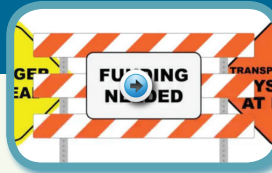
