## Another Successful Joint CPO Event!

Your CPO friends in Western Washington County were just doing what CPOs do best - *bringing valuable information on current local topics to their communities!*

Homelessness has become a major issue across all of Washington County. However, homelessness affects rural communities differently than urban communities. So on November 15—with support from CPOs 12C and 13—CPOs 10 and 15 hosted a forum entitled, “Homelessness - A Rural Conversation.” The goals for this special joint CPO meeting were to educate the community on a growing issue and to bring more awareness and compassion toward our homeless neighbors. The discussion was led by panelists from Washington County Housing Services, Sheriff’s Office, Family Promise, Forest Grove Temporary Emergency Shelter and community members. Current efforts to improve the homeless situation were shared.

The event was well attended and was given positive feedback by many of the attendees, including Commissioner Bob Terry, who referred to it as an illustration of a great CPO program.

## In Your Community

### New this year: Snow Zones in Washington County!

Snow zones are areas with steep grades and high elevations where **vehicles are required to have traction devices** during inclement weather. Motorists traveling in snow zones during inclement weather will be required by law to have traction devices on or in vehicles. Snow zones have the potential to increase safety and allow for more efficient plowing and sanding. During winter months the snow zones are marked with yellow signs that read, "Carry chains or traction tires." When snow zone restrictions are in effect, the message will change to "Chains required." CPO 1 is affected by this new requirement at **Barnes Road** from 118th Avenue east to the county line and **Cornell Road** from Cedar Hills Blvd east to the county line. For more info visit:
