NO. 820 Community Development Code / Board of Commissioners Hearing July 11, 10 am

Ordinance proposes to amend the code which applies to subdivisions and partitions for attached units on properties in the R-5 and R-6 Districts that are 2 acres or less. **Written comments**, including email, must contain author's name, address and phone.
