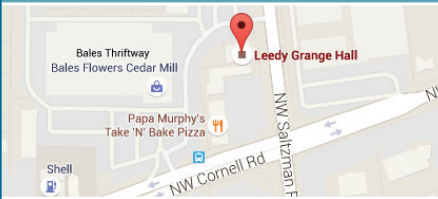

## 113th Avenue Pedestrian Pathway Improvement Project

Construction has begun to fill gaps in the existing pathway on the west side of 113th Avenue, increasing pedestrian safety by providing a dedicated walkway separated from vehicles. A five-foot wide pathway, separated from the roadway by a ditch, will be constructed along four sections of 113th Avenue to create a continuous walkway on the west side from Anderson Street to Rainmont Road.

**The County's Urban Roads Maintenance District (URMD) and the Minor Betterments Program are funding these improvements.** Every summer, the County recruits ideas for small-scale road improvements from the public. Later in the year, public input is sought in deciding which of the proposed improvements should be funded. You can help make your CPO 1 community a better place. What other improvements could be made in your community? Watch for the opportunity to provide your ideas!
