Get help with your transportation costs!

TriMet has implemented the new Low income Fare Program.

You may be able to ride TriMet for less. You qualify if you are 18-64 years old, an Oregon resident, making less than double the federal poverty level and not already using Honored Citizen fares. If you qualify, you'll be issued a personalized Hop card that lets you ride buses, MAX, WES, Portland Streetcar and C-TRAN for \$1.25 for a single ride, \$2.50 for a day pass or \$28 for a month pass. That's 50-72% less than adult fare.
