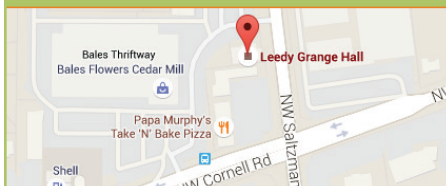

## Long Range Planning Issue Paper No. 2016-01 Now Available

### Addressing Walkway Gaps in the Urban Unincorporated Area

This Washington County Land Use & Transportation Issue Paper examines existing conditions and policies related to sidewalks and walkways, reviews sidewalk/walkway implementation methods for both development and public projects, and recommends several policy and procedural changes that would potentially result in more successful completion of sidewalks and walkways. To address gaps, staff proposes 14 recommendations divided into two types: "Potential Administrative Changes" (implemented by staff); and "Potential Legislative Changes" (require action by the Board of Commissioners). ## Draft 2016-17 Washington County Long Range Planning Annual Work Program

The County's draft Long Range Planning Annual Work Program is available for public review and comment through March 3. The program outlines work priorities for Land Use & Transportation Planning staff and recommended ordinance topics or projects for 2016-17.

**Priorities include the following:** Update Urban Planning Area Agreements between the County and cities; continue local, regional and state planning coordination, including Regional Growth Management decision, and coordinate with cities and Metro to plan for development of urban reserve areas, new urban areas and redevelopment plans for centers; continue Transportation Futures Study and Safe Routes to School program; implement new tools for eliminating walkway gaps; prepare Issue Paper to review infill development standards in R-5 and R-6 (limited to existing standards for privacy, screening, building orientation and other factors) and begin multi-disciplinary approach to address housing affordability.
