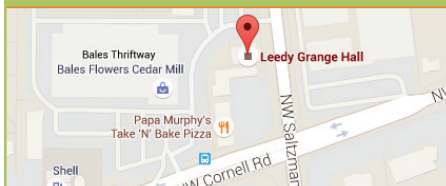

Boundary Advisory Committee Work Under Way

The Beaverton School District is in the process of conducting an adjustment of its high school boundaries to address increased population, overcrowding within schools in high growth areas, and future projected enrollment. A Boundary Advisory Committee, with representation by each high school's principal and community members, has begun studying boundaries, receiving public input, and preparing recommendations for the Superintendent. 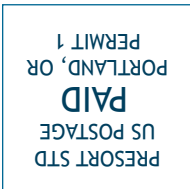
