On November 15, CPOs 10 and 15—with support from CPOs 12C and 13—hosted a forum entitled, “Homelessness - A Rural Conversation?” Although the event centered on the effects of homelessness on *rural* communities, the event drew people from across the county. The goals for this special joint CPO meeting were to educate the community on a growing issue and to bring more awareness and compassion toward our homeless neighbors. The discussion was led by panelists from Washington County Housing Services, Sheriff’s Office, Family Promise, Forest Grove Temporary Emergency Shelter and community members. Current efforts to improve the homeless situation were shared. The event was well attended and was given positive feedback by many of the attendees, including Commissioner Bob Terry, who referred to it as an illustration of a great CPO program.
