Washington County Department of Land Use & Transportation Annual Report Highlights Community Partnerships

Celebrating People & Partnerships Annual Report FY 2015-16 has been published online by the Washington County Department of Land Use & Transportation (LUT).

The annual report recognizes the collaborative partners who have contributed to the success of one of LUT's busiest years. Over the past fiscal year, the Department completed 73,164 building-related inspections and approved 1,612 subdivision lots. It maintained 3,014 road lane miles, 3,008 culverts and 184 bridges. It handled 2,615 requests for traffic signs, striping and other issues, and worked on 47 road design/construction projects.
