Proposed Zero Emission and Electric Vehicle Rebate Program in Oregon - Program would provide rebates towards the purchase or lease of a new electric vehicle. It would also provide for rebates towards the purchase or lease of a new or used electric vehicle if the purchaser meets three conditions: is from a low or moderate income household, resides in an area of the state with poor air quality due to transportation emissions, and scraps an internal combustion engine car that is at least 20 years old. The Department of Environmental Quality will accept public comments on this proposed rulemaking through March 14. There is also a hearing on February 26, 1 pm, 800 NE Oregon St., Portland.
