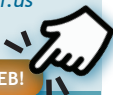

SW Quadrant Community Park - An Update

District staff will provide a check in on the new 21.5 acre SW Quadrant Community Park being built adjacent to Mountain View Middle School and Lawndale Park. The park is being designed, funded and programmed to provide upgraded, "universal accessibility" and Americans With Disabilities Act features, including athletic field surfacing, playground and other related amenities.

Projects Compete for Federal Dollars
Provide Your Input - By November 7

On the Proposed List:
Johnson St. Access to School

Metro is now seeking input as they consider how to allocate \$33 million in regional flexible funds (money from the federal government that can be used for a wide range of local transportation projects). The proposed project list has been released. The Metro Council will make a final funding decision on Jan. 26, based on comments submitted, technical analysis and advice from local leaders.

When completed, this project would create a safe walking and biking environment for students and others with continuous walkways, a bikeway and improved crosswalks along SW Johnson Street from Cornelius Pass to SW 185th. This project has been identified as a priority by the public and in a number of County documents: *Aloha Reedville Community Plan*, *TSP*, *Neighborhood Bikeway Plan*, and *School Access Improvement Study*.
