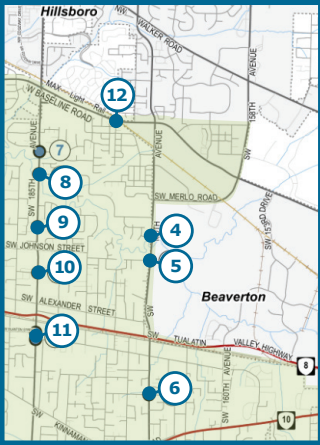

**Out of 12 sites recommended for improvements, eight pedestrian crossings have been selected for survey and design work for future improvements through the **Arterial Pedestrian Crossing Analyses Project**, all in CPO 6.**

An August 2017 online open house solicited public comment, which helped Washington County Department of Land Use & Transportation staff trim the list. Sites 4-6 are located along SW 170th. Sites 8-11 are located along 185th. Site 12 is on SW Baseline at the SW 175th Max crossing. The project is funded by a Metro Regional Flexible Funds grant. The survey and design work will help secure other sources to fund crossing improvements when larger road projects are scheduled.
