* Felicity Minteblanw spoke a few words about running for a position on the THPRD board in the May 16 election.

* Sheriff's office update by Deputy Erin Martinek and Specialist Darlene Schnoor:

- The Sheriff is forbidden by law from enforcing immigration law. The jail cannot hold anyone on an ICE detainer request, unless signed by a federal magistrate. Community trust is a cornerstone of law enforcement and everyone in the community should feel safe calling the Sheriff if they are a crime victim.
- On Fri, Mar 31 at 4-8pm is the Scooping with a Sheriff event at the Baskin Robbins on 185th & Farmington. This fundraiser benefits the December Shop with a Cop event that benefits students at Kinnaman Elementary School.
- On Thur, Mar 23 at 9-11am is the Coffee with a Cop at the Aloha McDonalds at 19525 TV Hiway. It connects deputies with the communities they serve and allows for coffee and conversation.

* Tualatin Hills Parks & Rec update by Tim Bonnin:

- Many events are scheduled for the next several months and they are listed on the web site. Events include a Dive-in movie at the Aloha Swim Center on Mar 4 and the Board meeting on Mar 14: <http://www.thprd.org/>
- The Crowel Woods park development is underway and the final plan is due by June.
- SW Community Park off of 170th Ave construction is underway and on schedule.

* Tualatin Valley Water District update by Jim Meierotto:

- The Grabhorn 5M gallon tank is in need of replacement. The old tank will be demo'd and replaced with a new one. They are hiring a design and build contractor now and the project will be complete in 2019.
- Divers recently went inside the Cooper Mtn. tank reservoir to clean and inspect it. There was a story in the newspaper about it.
- 60% of TVWD supplies come from Bull Run. Due to a cryptosporidium finding in multiple samples, Bull Run has been shut off and the Columbia River south shore wells have been activated.

* Willamette Water Supply update by David Marciniak and Kimi Sloop:

- They gave an update on the status of the routing of the new water pipe through the CPO6 territory. They are in the process of refining the route through Beaverton.
