TVF&R – Lt. Baker

- 183 incidents occurred since 1st of March, 157 were medical but also uptick in fires
- Check your smoke detector batteries and replace detectors every 10 years, rule of thumb is to check your batteries when the time shift occurs in spring and fall
- The CO2 detectors typically need replaced every 2-6 years, test them regularly as well
- Metro Roundup can help recycle/dispose of old detectors
- Directions provided on how to use a fire extinguisher and test them out in an open field
- Kitchen fires result from leaving food unattended with heat on, when extinguishing do not use water because it will likely spread flames. Best way to extinguish with lid. Keep oven shut for oven fires
- Back yard burning is not allowed within the burn zone outlined by the DEQ (www.deq.state.or.us → burning → open burn). Zone does include unincorporated Washington County.
