- TVF&R: Capt'n Pete Goden is the new station chief of Station 62 next to the CPO6 meetings.
- THPRD: Tim Bonnin update

  - Starting 6/1/17, no credit cards will be accepted by phone, only online (security and safety of the information)
  - On May 16, there will be a Crowell Park master plan presentation
  - Mountain View Champions Park is the new name for the SW Quadrant Park off of 170<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Ballot measure 34-272, Enhanced Sheriff's Patrol District 5 year levy: Lt. Ed Rawlinson update
  - The rate stays the same as the expiring levy: \$0.68/\$1k
  - Supports 66 deputies inside the UGB and outside city limits
- Sheriff's update: Lt. Ed Rawlinson. Three areas of increased study in Aloha this summer
  - Traffic crashes. Better analysis of the data and better enforcement.
  - Property crime. Predictive policing with Hunch Labs data analysis software with the goal to reduce crime by 10%
  - Specific problem houses: Targeted enforcement of houses with known drug and illegal activities. Learn how to deal with them.
- TVR&R Update: Public Information Officer Kim Haughn - AED Program
  - Pulsepoint now available for smartphones to allow anyone to be a first responder
  - Gives locations of AED's on map
  - TVF&R is piloting the program, but it is going nationwide.
