

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE DEFERRED SENTENCING PROGRAM RULES

The following is a list of conditions and requirements of the Deferred Sentencing Domestic Violence Program (DVDS). It should be further noted that if any of these conditions are violated or requirements are not fulfilled, it could lead to your revocation from DVDS and you would be sentenced to the crime which you initially plead to. By initialing next to each item, you affirm that you understand its meaning and agree to follow the directive.

1. ____ No contact with the victim(s) _____, which may include any minor children exposed to or affected by domestic violence unless authorized in writing by the Court.
2. ____ I agree to not intimidate, menace or have offensive contact, including language, with my victim or any other person. I agree to disclose any potential intimate relationships (prior to intimacy) to the DVDS Coordinator. Defendant shall consent to the Coordinator communicating with others about the defendant's domestic violence history.
3. ____ Subject to subsequent Court review, the DVDS Coordinator may suspend contact that has been previously granted.
4. ____ Report to the DVDS Coordinator as directed by the Court and/or the DVDS Coordinator.
5. ____ No commission of a new crime
6. ____ If you have any police contact, are arrested or charged with a new crime, you must contact the DVDS Coordinator immediately. Or if in custody, have a family member contact the DVDS Coordinator.
7. ____ Notify the DVDS Coordinator and Judge Menchaca of change in address or phone number within 24 hours. Notify Judge Menchaca at:

8. ____ Pay a DVDS monitoring fee in the amount of \$600 to Washington County Community Corrections. This fee must be paid in full by your 1 year status hearing to continue in the program. You may create a payment plan with DVDS Coordinator.
9. ____ Attend and complete a domestic violence intervention program, comply with the program's attendance policy, keep current on payments to the agency, attend all required classes and actively participate in your classes by completing required homework.
10. ____ Domestic violence intervention programs have varied requirements. You must follow the requirements of your specific program including attending the DV Victim's Panel. Sign a release of information for Community Corrections with treatment providers. You shall waive any confidentiality necessary in order to allow treatment providers to communicate with a victim.
11. ____ **If you or your partner** have children, you must complete a 12 week domestic violence related parenting program.
12. ____ Per DVDS Coordinator, before 90 day status hearing, you must submit to a polygraph examination to monitor your compliance with DVDS requirements and to have contact with your victim. Polygraph results will be a factor in successful completion of DVDS Program.

- 13.____ **YOU ARE NOT TO POSSESS OR USE ALCOHOL, MARIJUANA, OR ILLEGAL DRUGS.** All prescription information must be submitted to the DVDS Coordinator and your treatment provider.
- 14.____ If there is evidence of alcohol/drug issues, referrals for an evaluation and treatment may be made and you will be required to follow through.
- 15.____ You are required to submit to random urinalysis testing (UAs) at your domestic violence intervention classes, any alcohol/drug classes if required, and at the discretion of the DVDS Coordinator. All UAs must be submitted as required or it will be considered a refusal and a violation of the program requirements.
- 16.____ Do not participate in couples' counseling.
- 17.____ **DO NOT POSSESS ANY FIREARMS** during the Deferred Sentencing Program. Further, you shall not obtain a concealed handgun license, and if you have a concealed handgun license, you agree to immediately surrender it to your local sheriff's office. If you possess firearms, you agree to make arrangements approved by the DVDS coordinator for safekeeping with another.
- 18.____ In order to leave the State of Oregon, you need court authorization, you must request from the DVDS Coordinator via telephone or email 2 weeks prior to leaving. To do this, you need to provide details such as where you are going, how long you will be gone, and where you will be staying. **Request permission from your domestic violence provider if you need to miss group.**
- 19.____ You must disclose all past criminal history, from any/all jurisdictions and/or under a different name.
- 20.____ You shall not actively seek out communication with or information about the victim in any digital form. This includes but is not limited to social networking sites such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc... You shall not use a third party to contact the victim through any social medium. If you encounter anything that appears to contain information about the victim, you must not access that information. You shall not comment, publish, disseminate or create content regarding the victim on any publicly available digital or social media. This includes but is not limited to comments about your feelings towards the victim or the victim's conduct or treatment relating to your relationship with or feelings toward the victim.
