STATEMENT OF SPECIAL INSPECTIONS AND TESTING, AND STRUCTURAL OBSERVATIONS AGREEMENT

Special inspections, testing and structural observations shall be performed according to Oregon Structural Specialty Code (OSSC) Chapter 17.

In accordance with the OSSC §107.1, 1704.2, 1704.3 and 1704.5, the registered design professional in responsible charge (Architect and/or Engineer) shall submit a Statement of Special Inspections, and identify required Structural Observations. Special Inspections and Structural Observations identified below are to be listed on the drawings.

SPECIAL INSPECTORS Building Official will accept and review for approval, qualifications of all special inspectors or agencies registered in accordance with OSSC §1704.2.1.

The Special Inspector shall observe and document the work for conformance with the Building Services' approved plans and specifications, and applicable workmanship provisions of the OSSC. Discrepancies with the approved plans are to be brought immediately to the contractor's attention for correction. The Special Inspector shall file reports and a final summary letter with the Building Official.

BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED Architect or Engineer shall complete Parts A and B. The agency for the work identified in A and B shall be listed in Part C. If there is more than one agency a separate form is required for each.

REVISIONS Revisions to Parts A and B shall be submitted by the Architect or Engineer to Building Services for approval.

PRIOR TO RECEIVING FINAL INSPECTION Special Inspector or Inspection Agency and the Architect or the Engineer shall submit a final summary letter to the Building Official. The summary letter shall include a statement that all items requiring special inspection, testing and/or structural observations were fulfilled, reported and, to the best of their knowledge, in conformance with the Building Services' approved plans, specifications, county approved revisions and applicable provisions of the OSSC.
