County Permits Required For Work In The Public Right-Of-Way

FACILITY PERMIT

Required if work:

- is in existing or future County right-of-way,
- is in conjunction with a land use approval, and
- requires engineered plans.

Examples:

- sidewalk construction where there is no existing curb.
- changing road grade.
- road widening.
- construction of new streets.
- turn lanes.
- traffic signals.

Facility Permits are issued by Current Planning Services, Assurances Section (503) 846-3842. Inspections are performed by Engineering Division inspectors (503) 846-7900.

RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT (Driveway / Access, Utility Cuts, Sidewalk Repair, Dust Control, "No Spray" Signs, Neighborhood Watch Signs, Seasonal Irrigation, General Construction)

Required if work:

- is in existing County right-of-way,
- does not require engineered plans, and
- is not covered by a Facility Permit.

Examples:

- creation of a new access to a County road,
- repair, improvement or relocation of an existing access, including curb drops.
- rural subdivision or private road access with no other public right-of-way improvements,
- temporary (logging) access,
- installation of new public utilities in County right-of-way (permit issued directly to public utility company),
- new private connections to existing utilities in County right-of-way,
- repair of existing facilities in County right-of-way,
- installation of bus shelters,
- sidewalk construction where there is an existing curb,
- sidewalk and/or curb repairs,
- culvert installation, repair, or replacement,

The Operations Division (503) 846-7623 issues Right-of-Way Permits, and inspects all improvements constructed with the permit.
