Transportation Plan Update: Citizen Advisory Committee Application Information

Application Submittal Deadline: October 14, 2011

Thank you for considering serving on the Transportation Plan Update Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC). While the scope of work and schedule for the plan update is still under development, here's some basic information that will help you understand the group's general function and the nature of the commitment you'll be making.

A few general points:

- The CAC will be composed of citizens from different geographic subareas of the County and representatives of a range of interest groups. Representatives from some standing citizen committees that deal with transportation-related matters also are likely to be included.
- The CAC will play a regular and active role in helping review and propose changes to existing plan policy and strategy. The CAC will consider and suggest changes to systems serving all modes of transportation – motor vehicle, transit, bicycle and pedestrian.
- CAC work will be coordinated with that of a second committee, the Interagency Coordinating Committee (ICC). The primary focus of the ICC, composed of staff representatives from other local governments and service providers in Washington County, is to ensure planning work is consistent across jurisdictions.

Generally, CAC members should expect and be willing to:

- Attend meetings as necessary to discuss project issues, assist in policy development and to review and provide input on plan update products. (We expect this means six to eight CAC meetings of approximately two-hours each over the next 18-24 months.)
- Spend sufficient time outside of meetings to adequately review materials and/or otherwise prepare for the meetings themselves.
- Help communicate and discuss plan update progress with members of groups they represent or with community members with similar interests.

Updating the transportation plan process is a challenging enterprise. There will be considerable discussion and debate. There will also be lots of opportunities to learn about and help shape the transportation system that will serve county residents for the next 20 to 25 years.

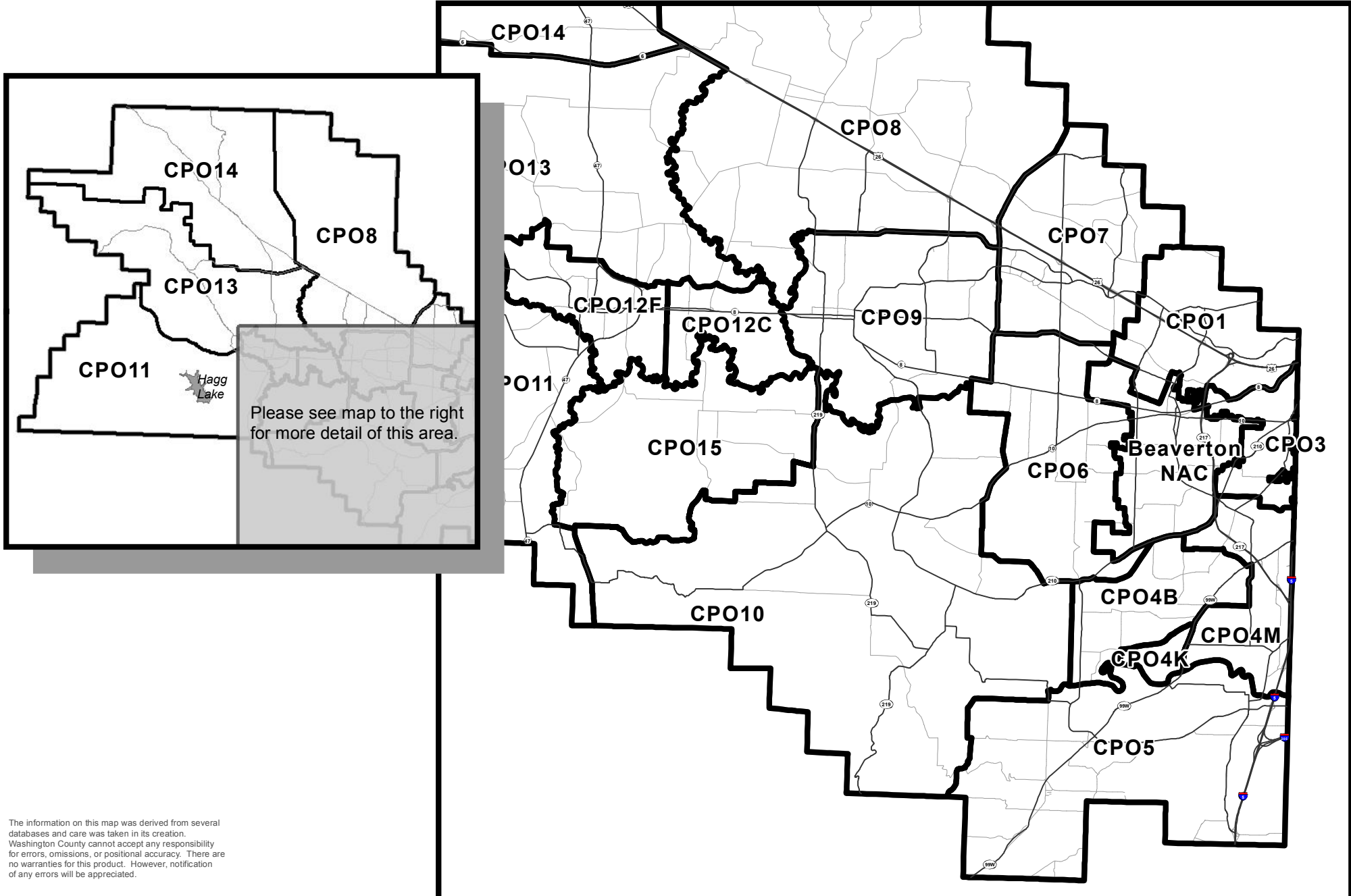
