SUMMARY:

A-Engrossed Ordinance No. 792 proposes to amend the Community Development Code (CDC) relating to standards for Medical Marijuana Dispensaries and repeals Ordinance No. 781, a temporary moratorium on the business or sale of medical marijuana. The Board conducted its initial hearing for Ordinance No. 792 on September 16, 2014 and directed engrossment of the ordinance to make a number of changes. A description of those changes was included in the staff report for the October 7, 2014 hearing. The Board held its first hearing for A-Engrossed Ordinance No. 792 on October 7 and continued the hearing to October 28, 2014.

The staff report for the October 28 hearing will be provided to the Board prior to the hearing and posted on the above land use ordinance web page. Copies of the report will also be available electronically and at the Clerk’s desk prior to the hearing.

Consistent with Board policy, testimony about the ordinance is limited to two minutes for individuals and five minutes for a representative of a group.
