Agenda Title: ACKNOWLEDGE THE TUALATIN VALLEY HIGHWAY CORRIDOR PLAN

SUMMARY:

The Tualatin Valley Highway Corridor Plan (TVCP) calls for Washington County to adopt the TVCP by ordinance into the Transportation System Plan (TSP) to guide the management of and improvements to the transportation network in the corridor.

A-Engrossed Ordinance No. 783 and A-Engrossed Ordinance 768 (adopted in 2013) update the Washington County Transportation System Plan (TSP) consistent with the recommendations of the TVCP. This includes changing the designation of Tualatin Valley Highway from a seven-lane Principal Arterial to a five-lane Arterial and adding a Refinement Area to facilitate the future planning of high capacity transit in the corridor. Many additional details specified in the TVCP are at a level of design beyond what is necessary or appropriate for the TSP. Therefore, staff recommends that the Board acknowledge the TVCP by Resolution and Order. The TVCP was initially attached to the technical materials supporting the August 5, 2014 staff report on A-Engrossed Ordinance No. 783. The TVCP is addressed in the staff report for A-Engrossed Ordinance No. 783.
