1. Welcome, Introductions and Approval of September 2020 Minutes

Chair Jamieson called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m. He welcomed members and staff.

Member Riedweg moved to approve the September 2020 minutes. Member Farrar seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Guest Comments

There were no guests present.

3. Update on Martin Road Roundabout and Farmington Road/River Road Intersection Project

Renus Kelfkens shared an update on the Martin Road roundabout and the Farmington Road/River Road intersection improvements, using a PowerPoint titled "Martin Road Roundabout and Farmington/River Road Intersection Project Update."

4. Report on Pavement Condition Index (PCI) and Rural Roads

Brian Irish presented Pavement Condition Index (PCI) data for rural roads in the county. He

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shared that the county allowed a vendor to do a 1,000-foot test section of a seal coat product on Simpson Road. The product is liquid asphalt with sand built into it as aggregate. It is called micro-coat and is a seal coat option, different than our standard chip seal. The immediate result is excellent; we can decide whether to adopt it as one of our treatments once we see how it weathers. The cost is only cents more than our current treatment. Member Riedweg stated that he has driven Simpson Road and is pleased with it so far.

5. Update on South Road Bridge Analysis

Todd Watkins provided an update on South Road bridge. Todd stated there is nothing new to report, as staff had to stop its analysis during the recent Washington County fires that directly impacted the South Road bridge vicinity. The analysis will resume shortly, now that the fires are extinguished.

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has recommended weight limit removals for three bridges in the county, located on Hoff Road, Padgett Road, and Minter Bridge Road. Todd showed a site map titled "Remove Bridge Weight Limit" indicating the location of the three bridges.

ODOT has also recommended substantial weight limit decreases for three other bridges in the county, located on South Road, Pongratz Road, and 205th Ave.

6. Update on Pottratz Road

Stephen Cruise shared an update regarding the closure on Pottratz Road. He shared a site map showing Pottratz Road, titled "Existing."

Discussion followed regarding public use of the road, moving the barriers further down, notice when work begins, and communicating appropriate use of the road to the public.
