1 (Very Poor)	No roadway crown or road is bowl shaped with extensive ponding. Severe rutting (over 3" deep), over 25% of the area. Severe potholes (over 4" deep), over 25% of area. Many areas (over 25%) with little or no aggregate.	Travel may be difficult and road may be closed at times. Needs rehabilitation.			(multiply by 5)
