CONDITIONS

Sign Placement

- Place signs, provided by the County, at the right-of-way line on a fence post, sturdy pole or some other solid object. Trees, buildings, mailboxes, County sign posts and utility poles are NOT acceptable objects for installation.
- Signs should be four (4) feet above the shoulder. Never place signs in the shoulder or within three (3) feet of the shoulder.
- Place the “X” sign at the beginning and the “O” sign at the end of the area not to be treated to delineate the “No Spray” area to be exempt from spraying.
- If you and your neighbor have adjacent areas that are not to be sprayed, ensure that the signs are coordinated and installed as a continuous area to prevent confusion.
- **Keep all weeds, grass, brush, and limbs cut away from the signs to ensure their visibility at all times.** If a sign is damaged, return the sign to the Operations Division (503.846.7623) for replacement.

Vegetation Management

- Manage the vegetation in the right-of-way, within the identified “No Spray” area, to ensure the following are maintained so as not to compromise, impede or block:
 - **Drainage** - Storm drains, culverts and the first three feet of road shoulder must be free of vegetation to ensure proper road drainage. Ditches may have short grasses that slow the flow of water without blockage.
 - **Sight Distance** - Clear vegetation near intersections and on curves to maximize sight distance.
 - **Shoulders & Roadway** – Prevent vegetation from encroaching the road shoulder and roadway.

Failure to Maintain

- Failure to maintain the vegetation to the County's satisfaction may cause the County to exercise its right to:
 - Spray the right-of-way with herbicide;
 - Perform the necessary vegetation management (which may not be completed with the same level of finesse as the property owner);
 - Terminate this Agreement prior to the termination date.
