Candidates for construction in 2015-2016

Candidate 223a – Kaiser Road



Need/request: Fill gaps in existing sidewalks/pathways along Kaiser Road between Purvis and Mitchell so pedestrians do not have to walk in the travel lane with vehicles or alongside the road in the grass and mud.

Proposed solution: Construct about 100 feet of 5-foot-wide paved pathway, separated from the travel lane behind the ditch, along the east side from Hanse Ridge Park to 4190 Kaiser Road. This will provide a continuous pedestrian walkway along the east side of Kaiser from West Union to Laidlaw.

Estimated cost: \$56,000 assuming some drainage improvements may be required and adequate right-of-way exists behind the ditch.
