At its December 17, 2014, meeting the Urban Road Maintenance District Advisory Committee (URMDAC) reviewed the list of eligible safety improvement candidates and recommended that public comments be gathered on the top 22 candidates. A public outreach initiative was launched January 5, and public comments were taken through February 13.

After reviewing public comments and hearing public testimony during their February 18, 2015, meeting, URMDAC selected the following six safety improvement projects for funding in fiscal year 2015-2016:

- Pedestrian path on **Rock Creek Boulevard** from house #20175 to Rock Creek Drive (CPO 7)
- Pedestrian path on **90th Avenue** from Stark to SW Leahy (CPO 1)
- Pedestrian path on **Kinnaman Road** to fill gaps from house #20660 to 200th (CPO 6)
- Pedestrian path on **113th Avenue** from Anderson to Rainmont (CPO 1)
- Pedestrian path on **174th Avenue** from Park View Drive to Bethany Elementary School entrance (CPO 7)
- Pedestrian path on **Bull Mountain Road** to fill gaps from Grandview Lane to 133rd (CPO 4B)

The estimated cost for these six projects is about \$2.6 million.
