Welcome

Gary Virgin called the meeting to order at 7:35 a.m. April minutes were approved by the committee.

Dick Road

Greg Clemmons gave a presentation regarding Dick Road. Lynn Jacobs, owner of La Finquita del Buho, shared the history of her farm and the concern over the dust that is ruining their crops. Fred Meisner of Cascadian Nursery expressed his concern that the recent reversion of Dick Road appears to have made the road more dangerous than it was before the reversion. Keith Fishback suggested a possible LID.

Ken Moyle motioned that the La Finquita del Buho frontage be recalculated using a high value and high sensitivity rating on the priority matrix, West Union to Farm Park Drive. Wendy Mortensen seconded the motion. All were in favor. The matrix will be updated.

Several scenarios were looked at including a suggestion by Ken Moyle to have dust abatement assistance from the County. Dave Schamp said it doesn't meet the safety criteria. Ken motioned that the County look at funding dust abatement based on safety criteria. Lars Wahlstrom seconded the motion. Four were opposed, three were in favor, and two abstained from the vote.

Land Development permits are in place for the business traffic that currently exists on this road. Dave Vanasche motioned to have Greg Clemmons put together two or three different scenarios, enter the road into the priority calculations and bring back the updated list to the next meeting. Wendy Mortensen seconded the motion. All were in favor.

The group was reminded to review Commissioner Duyck's letter regarding Dick Road and also to check on Reiling Road.

ODOT Update

Karla Keller and Ron Kroop with ODOT discussed current and upcoming ODOT projects (see attached lists).

Karla agreed that RROMAC should be included in the planning stages for projects.

MISCELLANEOUS

Gary Virgin would like an update from CPM on what is happening between 170th and Kinnaman. Dan Brown will be invited to the next meeting.

Bill Ewers questioned the multiple variations of striping on Hwy 219. Ron Kroop, ODOT agreed to a joint presentation with county staff at the next RROMAC meeting to discuss pavement markings.

Wendy Mortensen motioned to adjourn the meeting and Lars Wahlstrom seconded the motion.
