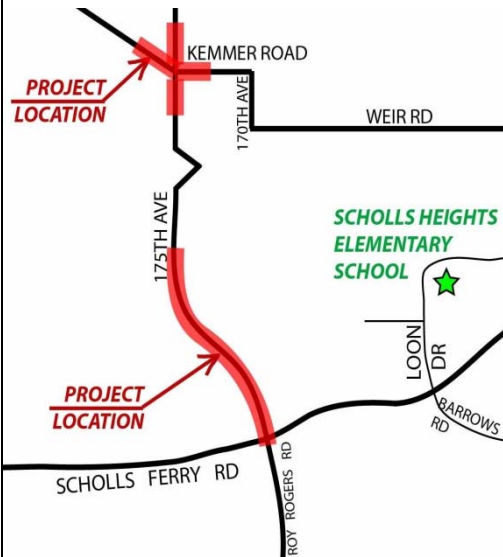

Washington County invites you to attend a combined project open house for two upcoming 175th Avenue projects. Staff representing both projects would like to introduce the proposed improvements to the public and will be soliciting comments. No formal presentation is planned; stop by any time during open house hours.

PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS

The intersection of 175th and Kemmer experiences inefficiencies in traffic flow at peak travel times due to its current four-way stop configuration. Concepts such as a roundabout or traffic signal are being analyzed. After receiving feedback from the public, the preferred alternative will be taken through final design and into construction. Construction is expected to occur in 2018.

175th from Scholls Ferry to 500 feet south of Alvord will be improved to two lanes and each direction with a center turn lane, bike and pedestrian facilities, street lighting, and an upgraded drainage system. Construction is scheduled to begin in 2017.
