THE URBAN ROAD MAINTENANCE DISTRICT (URMD) IS A COUNTY SERVICE DISTRICT. THOSE WHO OWN PROPERTY WITHIN THE DISTRICT PAY A TAX FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE OF NEIGHBORHOOD STREETS WITHIN URMD. URMD ALSO FUNDS SMALL-SCALE PEDESTRIAN AND BIKING IMPROVEMENTS.

GAIN SHARE IS A PORTION OF STATE INCOME TAX REVENUES. IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, DEPARTMENT OF LAND USE & TRANSPORTATION (LUT) GAIN SHARE FUNDS ARE ALLOCATED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO IMPROVE PUBLIC SERVICES, INCLUDING PEDESTRIAN SAFETY AND ACCESS TO SCHOOLS.
