Legal Research Materials Not Available Online

- Oregon legislative history (older statutes, OARs, minutes, exhibits, etc.).
- The majority of current and older secondary resources (texts, monographs, treatises, hornbooks, etc.)
- Full runs of superseded court rules, supplementary local rules, appellate rules and procedures, etc.
- Oregon MCLE program course books.
- OCDLA publications.
- Authoritative (citable) legal dictionaries and thesauri
- Authoritative (citable) medical dictionaries
- Superseded Blue Books and other citation manuals.
- OSB & OCDLA legislative highlights, court briefs, committee reports
- Older municipal codes & ordinances.
- Jury instructions, judicial bench books, ADR materials.
- Older disciplinary reports and Bar directories.
- Older lawyer locator services, bar publications, newsletters, etc.

Legal Materials Online, but Not Free (or even easy)

- Superseded official state statutes, official cases, etc.
- Many legal forms
- Online subscription databases (OJIN, Westlaw, Lexis, Loislaw, OSB BarBooks, etc.), including, but not limited to:
 - Case law
 - Dockets
 - Digest services
 - Law Reviews (full runs)
 - Citators (Lexis Shepard's or Westlaw KeyCite)
 - Legal encyclopedias
 - Annotations.
