### Man Arrested on Multiple Charges After Trying to Stab Others at Bar

January 14, 2018 – A man was arrested on multiple charges after he tried to stab other patrons and security staff at an Aloha bar.

On Sunday, January 14, 2018 at 12:06 a.m., Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to Club Underground at 18641 SW TV Highway in Aloha after multiple 911 callers reported a man armed with a knife causing a disturbance.

When deputies arrived, they found security staff on the floor, struggling with a man armed with a knife. During the struggle, the male swung the knife at others in an attempt to stab them. He suffered a minor cut to his own hand. Ultimately, the man was disarmed and detained.

During their investigation, deputies learned that the altercation started when a man accidentally bumped into another man while entering the restroom. A short time later, when the male left the restroom, the other male flashed some hand signals and produced a knife.

Security staff immediately intervened and several patrons called 911. Fortunately, no one was seriously injured.

Deputies arrested Jonathan Lemarroy, 39, of Hillsboro, and charged him with assault in the second degree, riot, menacing, felon in possession of a weapon, disorderly conduct in the second degree, unlawful use of a weapon and parole violation. His bail is set at \$250,000.
