### Results: Deputies Arrest 78 Impaired Drivers in June

July 2, 2018 – During enhanced patrols in the month of June, Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies arrested 78 impaired drivers. That equates to an average of over two and a half DUII arrests each day. Thirteen of those drivers were arrested for drug impairment.

### Deputies Arrest 18 Impaired Drivers Over Memorial Day Weekend, Continue Enhanced Patrols in June

May 31, 2018 – Between Friday, May 25 and Monday, May 28, 2018, Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies arrested 18 impaired drivers. Deputies would like to remind the public that impaired driving is a preventable offense and to always designate a sober driver.

In partnership with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), and Oregon State Sheriff's Association (OSSA), will be conducting high visibility enforcement patrols looking for impaired drivers during the entire month of May.
