## Murder Suspect Identified in Rock Creek Shooting

July 23, 2019

Detectives from the Washington County Sheriff's Office Violent Crimes Unit have identified a suspect in the deadly shooting of 18-year-old Fermin Alonso-Alonso of North Plains.

Torrey Caprice Brumfield is accused of shooting Mr. Alonso-Alonso during a house party that was being held at a short-term rental house in the 17700 block of NW Connett Meadow Court in the unincorporated area of Rock Creek on September 30, 2018.

Mr. Brumfield is currently in the custody of the Oregon Department of Corrections serving a sentence on unrelated charges. He will be returned to Washington County to face charges of murder, unlawful use of a weapon (two counts), and felon in possession of a firearm.

## **18-Year-Old Fatally Shot in Rock Creek, Suspect Sought**

September 30, 2018

On Sunday, September 30, 2018, at 12:47 a.m., Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to reports of gunfire at a residence in the 17700 block of Northwest Connett Meadow Court in the Rock Creek community. Initial reports were that someone had been shot during an altercation at a large party at the location.

Deputies arrived and rendered medical aid to an 18-year-old male suffering from life-threatening injuries. Investigators learned the suspect fled the scene in the moments after the shooting. Multiple deputies searched the area but were unable to locate the suspect.

The victim was transported to a local trauma hospital where he was later pronounced deceased.

Detectives with the inter-agency Washington County Major Crimes Team are leading the investigation. Personnel with the Oregon State Police Forensic Services Division are assisting at the scene.

This investigation is in its early stages and no suspect information is available for release at this time. Investigators continue to interview witnesses and collect additional information.

Detectives would like to speak with anyone who attended the party or has information regarding the incident. Individuals with information are asked to call the sheriff's office at (503) 846-2700.

Beaverton Police, Hillsboro Police, Oregon State Police, Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue, and Metro West Ambulance assisted during the incident.
