## **Deputies Ask for Public's Help Locating a Missing and Endangered Man**

January 5, 2022

On Wednesday, January 5, 2022, at 1:10 p.m., Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies learned 79-year-old Chong Ho Kim was missing. Family members said Kim has been missing since Tuesday afternoon, January 4, 2022. Kim was last seen near the Stafford Court Apartments on SW 180th Avenue in Aloha.

Kim is 5'3", 140 lbs., with grey hair and brown eyes. Kim was wearing black shoes, grey pants, a long winter coat, and has eyeglasses. Kim does not have a vehicle or cell phone.
